Connect the letters in the circle to make hidden words.

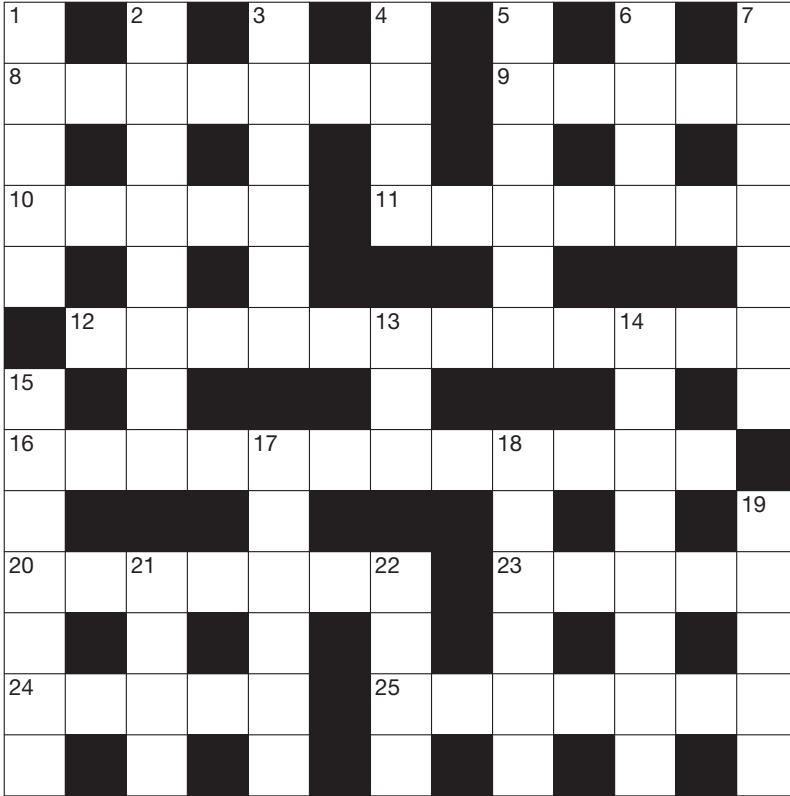
### Playing Trivia

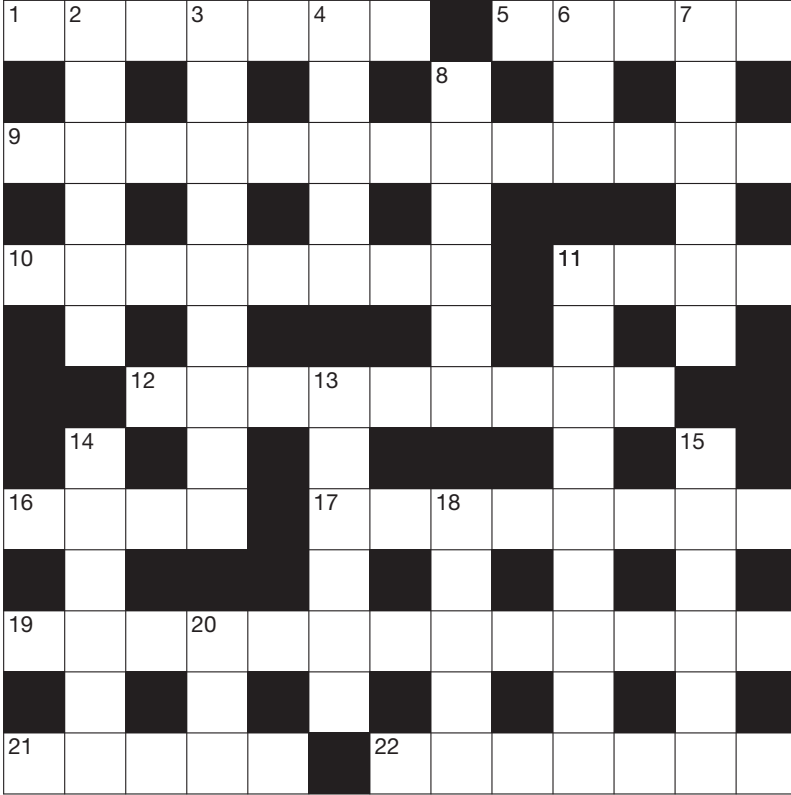
Friends or relatives who are unable to attend the funeral in person can still be part of the chapel service by watching and listening from anywhere in the world via the live web-stream or Zoom.

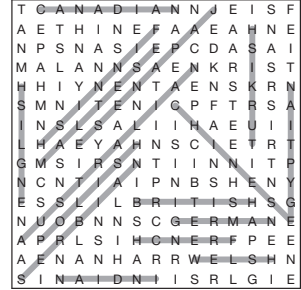
